IMPORTANT MESSAGE TO TEAMS, PARENTS & FANS

Thank you again for playing in the 2017 PrimeTime Sports National Basketball Championship. The various communities of the Dallas area and their hotel properties are key supporters of PrimeTime Sports and the National Championship. To maintain this supportive relationship, we ask your assistance in communicating to your players and fans that it is essential that they conduct themselves responsibly, respectfully and in a mature fashion at all times, including as guests of the hotels and court facilities.

Your team's compliance with these *Conduct Expectations* is a condition of participation. PrimeTime Sports has advised the Host Hotels and facilities that inappropriate behavior, such as excessive noise, setting off fire alarms, property damage, irresponsible use of alcohol, failure to follow hotel or facility rules, etc. by anyone associated with the competing teams is unacceptable and will not be tolerated. The hotel and facility management and staff have been instructed to report any problems of this nature to PrimeTime Sports, including the identity of any person or team with inappropriate behavior. If such a report is received with regard to any team, we will take disciplinary action against the team, including consideration of removal of the team from the tournament, without any refund of the entry fee.

Inappropriate conduct risks the loss of support from facilities, hotels, and communities, which in turn will increase the cost of the tournament to the teams or even the possible loss of the event. PrimeTime Sports has invested far too much time, energy and resources to allow this to happen.

With regard to hotels, gyms and all event venues, teams, their players and their fans must recognize **we are all guests** of the respective hotels and facilities and we must conduct ourselves in a responsible, mature and respectful manner, as well as follow all rules and regulations of the hotel or facility. Failure to do so, risks your team's ability to participate in this and future events. One of the biggest challenges of hosting an event of this size is to secure adequate gym space for more than 2,500 games that will be played. The poor conduct or bad judgment of a single person can result in a hotel or facility not being available for future events. Please see that your team and supporters are the gracious guests that will assure that this event can continue to grow and maintain its position as the largest single venue National Basketball Championship in the country!
